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## Additional Instructions

**For purposes of obtaining preferential tariff treatment, this document must be completed legibly and in full by the certifier and be in the possession of the importer at the time the declaration is made. The certifier may be the exporter, producer or importer of the CUSMA-eligible goods.**

**Field 1: MULTIPLE SHIPMENTS BLANKET PERIOD (DD/MM/YYYY)**

Complete field if the certification covers multiple shipments of identical goods as described in Field 7(b) that are imported into a CUSMA country for a specified period of **up to** one year (blanket period). "FROM" is the date upon which the certification becomes applicable to the good covered by the blanket certification. "TO" is the date upon which the blanket period expires. The importation of a good for which preferential tariff treatment is claimed based on this certification must occur between these dates.

**Field 2: SINGLE SHIPMENT DETAIL**

Complete if the certification is applicable to a single shipment. Indicate "YES" along with the invoice number when applicable.

**Field 3: CERTIFIER INFORMATION (Name and Address, incl Country):**

Provide the certifier's name, address (including country), telephone number, and email address.

**Field 4: EXPORTER (Name and Address, incl Country)**

Provide the exporter's name, address (including country), e-mail address, and telephone number if different from the certifier. This information is not required if the producer is completing the certification of origin and does not know the identity of the exporter. The address of the exporter shall be the place of export of the good in a Party's territory.

**Field 5: PRODUCER (Name and Address, incl Country)**

Provide the producer's name, address (including country), e-mail address, and telephone number, if different from the certifier or exporter or, if there are multiple producers, state "Various" or provide a list of producers. A person that wishes for this information to remain confidential may state "Available upon request by the importing authorities". The address of a producer shall be the place of production of the good in a Party's territory.

**Field 6: IMPORTER (Name and Address, incl Country)**

Provide, if known, the importer's name, address, e-mail address, and telephone number. The address of the importer shall be in a Party's territory.

**Field 7: ITEM/PRODUCT NUMBER AND DESCRIPTION**

Add the item or product number for each good, if applicable (optional). Provide a description of the good. The description should be sufficient to relate it to the good covered by the certification. If the certification of origin covers a single shipment of a good, indicate, if known, the invoice number related to the exportation.

**Field 8: HS CLASSIFICATION NUMBER**

Provide the HS tariff classification of the good to the 6-digit level.

**Field 9: ORIGIN CRITERION**

Specify the origin criterion under which the good qualifies, as set out in Article 4.2 (Originating Goods).

- A** Wholly obtained or produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties, as defined in Article 4.3 (Wholly Obtained or Produced Goods).
- B** Produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties using non-originating materials provided the good satisfies all applicable requirements of Annex 4-B (Product-Specific Rules of Origin)
- C** Produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties exclusively from originating materials.
- D** Except for a good provided for in Chapter 61 to 63 of the Harmonized System:
  - (i) produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties;
  - (ii) the Harmonized System used in the production of the good cannot satisfy the requirements set out in Annex 4-B (Product-Specific Rules of Origin) because both the good and its materials are classified in the same subheading or same heading that is not further subdivided into subheadings or, the good was imported into the territory of a Party in an unassembled or a disassembled form but was classified as an assembled good pursuant to rule 2(a) of the General Rules of Interpretation of the Harmonized System; and
  - (iii) the regional value content of the good, determined in accordance with Article 4.5 (Regional Value Content), is not less than 60 percent if the transaction value method is used, or not less than 50 percent if the net cost method is used; and the good satisfies all other applicable requirements of this Chapter.

**Field 10: COUNTRY OF ORIGIN**

Identify the name of the country ("MX" or "US" for goods exported to Canada; "US" or "CA" for goods exported to Mexico; or "CA" or "MX" for goods exported to the United States) to which the preferential rate of customs duty applies, as set out in Chapter 4, Rules of Origin.

**Field 11: CERTIFICATION**

The certification must be completed, signed and dated by the Certifier. Print or type the full name of the certifier, full legal name of the company, the certifier's title, phone number and email address. The date should be the signing date of the certification. Specify the total number of pages of the certification, including any continuation pages, where indicated.
